

COTTAGE RULES

- Head Beach Office hours are from 9 am to 7 pm on Saturdays, and 9 am to 5 pm Sunday through Friday.
- Check in time is 3 pm. and check out time is 10 am. Please note that there is a \$50.00 charge for late check out.
- To avoid towing, all registered guests must have a dated tag displayed on their vehicle in order to enter and park at the beach. Tags will be given at the office during check in. Please do not transfer tag to person(s) not registered at Head Beach.
- No tents, campers or trailers are to be set up at the cottage.
- There is a limit of one car per bedroom at each cottage.
- If a light bulb burns out, we will replace it upon notification. We ask that you do not change the bulb since many fixtures require a ladder to reach and all fixtures have a maximum limit of 60 watts.
- Please respect the maximum occupancy limit.
- For the facilities, natural waste and paper only. No foreign objects, feminine hygiene products, or diapers.
- No pets.
- Garbage is collected on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday. Please be sure the bins are not blocked or covered.
- There is no wood burning (fire pits or wood fueled devices) allowed. Properly maintained and adult supervised grills are permitted, but please remember to properly dispose of the coals.
- Do not remove the battery from the smoke detector.
- If you move furniture, please return it to its proper place. Do not leave it outside.
- When your stay is over, please do not throw food on the ground. Seagulls do not have time to eat it before it has to be raked up for the next guest.
- Accidents happen. If something breaks during your stay, please notify the office as soon as possible.
- Reservations are taken one year in advance, so to ensure the same week in the same cottage for the following year, please be sure to fill out a reservation slip at the Office prior to your departure.
- Emergency messages, at our discretion, will be delivered as soon as possible; all other messages will be held at the Office for seven days and will be the renter's responsibility to check.
- We hope you have a great vacation. If you have any questions, or if a problem arises, please notify the office for assistance.
