We offer rustic cottages on the coast of Maine with free access for our guests to our privately-owned beach. All cottages are rented from Saturday to Saturday. Check in time is 3pm, (keys will not be issued before this time) and check out is 10am: there is a fifty-dollar fee for late check out. All kitchens are equipped with cook stove, refrigerator and cooking/eating utensils. Bathrooms have full fixtures which includes an upright shower stall. Pillows are standard, but please note that we do not supply bed linens or towels. All cottages have full sized mattresses. Heat is provided by electric wall mounted heaters. There is one car per bedroom allowed per cottage. Also, there are a maximum number of people allowed per cottage (listed above). Please note that the cottages are equipped based on the number of bedrooms (2 persons per); if you decide to include extra persons (up to the maximum occupancy limit) it is the renter's responsibility to provide any extra needs. No tents, campers, or trailers are to be parked or set up at the cottage. Pets are not permitted. There is no burning of wood allowed, but properly maintained and supervised propane grills are permitted. There is no smoking inside of the cottage. A one hundred dollar (\$100.00) non-refundable deposit, per cottage and per rented week, is required to hold a reservation. A deposit request will be sent in January, or if you rent after January, within 14 days of making your reservation so please be sure that any information you leave with us is complete and accurate.
